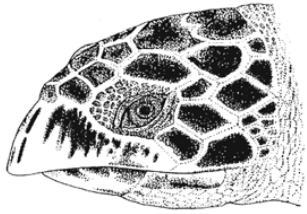


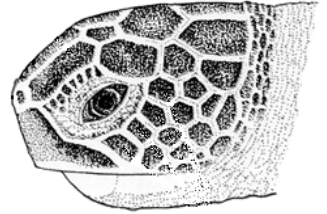

(Eretmochelys imbricata)

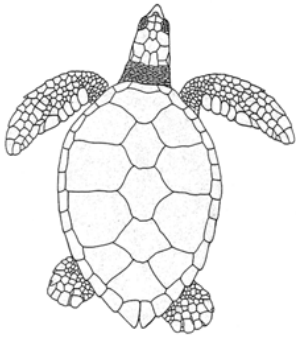

(Chelonia mydas)



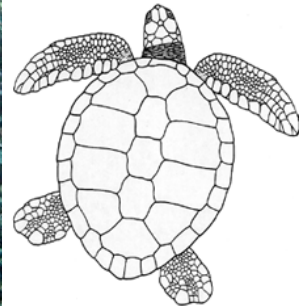
- *Narrow head & pointed beak
- *4 prefrontal scales (between eyes)



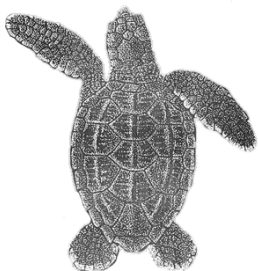
- *Rounded head
- *2 prefrontal scales (between eyes)



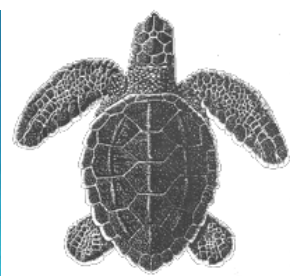
- *Overlapping scutes on carapace (like shingles)
- *Serrated edges when young (less obvious on adults)
- *2 claws per flipper



- *Adjoining scutes on carapace (like tiles)
- *Carapace has smoother edges
- *1 claw per flipper



*Hatchlings are all brown



*Hatchlings are gray with white plastrons
